

Bill No. 106 of 1953

A BILL TO AMEND THE ALBERTA LAND
SURVEYORS ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Alberta Land Surveyors Act*, being chapter 287 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 20 is struck out and a new section substituted. This section provided for the holding of examinations at the University of Alberta on the 4th Monday in January in each year and at such other times as the General Faculty Council determined. The new section provides for no such definite date and permits the holding of examinations on such dates as the General Faculty Council determines.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Alberta Land Surveyors Act

(Assented to _____, 1953)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Land Surveyors Act*, being chapter 287 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 20 is struck out and the following is substituted:

"**20.** Examinations of candidates for admission to study or practise as Alberta land surveyors shall be held at such times as the General Faculty Council of the University of Alberta may determine."
