

An Act to amend The Alberta Land Surveyors Act

(Assented to April 2, 1953)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

1. The Alberta Land Surveyors Act, being chapter 287 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
2. Section 20 is struck out and the following is substituted
"20. Examinations of candidates for admission to study or practise as Alberta land surveyors shall be held at such times as the General Faculty Council of the University of Alberta may determine."
3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

CHAPTER 1

An Act to amend The Aerial Photographic Survey Act

(Assented to March 31, 1953)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

1. The Aerial Photographic Survey Act, being chapter 1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1951, is hereby amended.
2. Section 2 is amended by adding immediately after clause (d) the following new clause
"(e) 'regulations' means the regulations established under this Act."
3. Section 6 is amended by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following
"6. (1) Unless the applicant maintains a place of business within the Province, he shall furnish to the Minister before the issue of a license, a cash bond as guarantee that the aerial photographic survey and other related matters will be conducted in accordance with this Act and the regulations.
" (1a) The amount of the cash deposit shall be
"(u) the sum of three thousand dollars where the area to be surveyed is over fifty square miles,
"(b) the sum of one thousand dollars where the area to be surveyed is under fifty square miles."
4. This Act comes into force on the first day of July, 1953.
