CHAPTER 52

An Act to amend The Alberta Land Surveyors Act

(Assented to March 30, 1954)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Land Surveyors Act*, being chapter 287 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
2. Section 3 is struck out and the following is substituted: Section 3
amended
3. (1) Subject to the provisions of *The Oil and Gas Resources Conservation Act, 1950*, *The Right of Entry Arbitration Act, 1952*, and to any rules of practice or procedure established thereunder, no person within the Province shall act as a surveyor of any land other than land held in the right of Canada unless he has been duly authorized to practise as a land surveyor pursuant to the provisions of this Act and is registered under this Act.  (2) A person contravening subsection (1) is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than forty nor more than one hundred dollars and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term of not more than three months." Penalty
3. Section 7, subsection (3), is amended by striking out the word "may" and by substituting the word "shall". Section 7
amended
4. Section 23 is struck out and the following is substituted: Section 23
amended
 "23. Every applicant or candidate for admission as an articulated student or otherwise shall before being examined for any purpose under this Act by the General Faculty Council of the University of Alberta, pay to the Registrar of the University of Alberta the fees chargeable by the General Faculty Council of the University for the examination and certificate." 5. Section 26 is amended by adding immediately after the word "sections" the figures "25". Section 26
amended
6. Section 40 is amended by striking out the words "and shall enter opposite the names of all registered persons who have died a statement of the fact". Section 40
amended
7. Form C in the Schedule is amended by striking out the word "penal" where it occurs in paragraph ten. Schedule
amended
8. This Act comes into force on the first day of July, 1954. Coming into
